- The sign off sheet regarding your child's use of the internet and whether or not you give permission to use his / her photograph on the district website.


Lunch, Breakfast, and Milk

This year's prices are as follows: Full priced lunch is \$2.70 per day, and the reduced rate is \$.40 per day. Full priced breakfast is \$1.25 per day, and reduced breakfast is \$.40 per day. Milk costs \$.55 cents. All parents should complete and return lunch applications if you feel you qualify for free or reduced lunches. We will continue to use last year's lunch data until September 30th. All accounts will go to full payment on October 1st if a new application has not been received. Applications are forwarded to the Superintendent's office to be processed. Eligibility is determined by central administration staff. Please note: If your financial situation changes you can fill out an application at any time during the school year.
